



## **Jesus: What He Said and What He Did**

Based on the book by Ignasi Ricart and Maria Rius | Study Guide

This video offers an opportunity to the primary and intermediate students to reflect on Jesus' life here on earth. After showing the film, discuss the following questions as a way of integrating the examples into the real life experiences of your students.

- 1) Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River. God told everyone there that Jesus was His beloved Son and they should listen to Him.  
What happened to you when you were baptized?
- 2) Jesus told his disciples many things about God's Kingdom.  
What do you think God's Kingdom should be like?
- 3) Jesus called twelve people to be His apostles. How can you follow Jesus like they did?
- 4) Jesus told the story of the Prodigal Son. How is the sacrament of Reconciliation like the story of the Prodigal Son?
- 5) Jesus told the story of the Good Samaritan. Have you ever helped someone who was lonely or hurt? How were you like the Good Samaritan?
- 6) Jesus taught his friends the Our Father. What part of this prayer do you like best?
- 7) People greeted Jesus on Palm Sunday and called Him their king. What would you say to Jesus if you could meet Him on the street?
- 8) Jesus gathered his twelve apostles together for His Last Supper. He washed their feet and talked to them. He gave them the special gift of Himself. How is the sacrament of the Eucharist like this Last Supper?
- 9) What is the greatest thing Jesus did for all of us? When do we celebrate it? How can you thank Jesus in a special way for the gift of salvation?
- 10) After Jesus' resurrection and ascension to Heaven, the early believers of Jesus started the Church. How are you and your classmates like the first group of Christians?

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
